
BADGE AND PATCH



1904 RISING SUN BADGE


- The distinctive shape of the badge, worn on the upturned brim of a slouch hat, is commonly identified with the Spirit of Anzac.
- To date there have been seven different versions of the Australian rising sun badge.
- The 2/22nd would have worn the 1904 version, the third of the rising sun series.
- The basic form of the 1904 version has remained unchanged, although the wording on the scroll, and the style of crown has been amended.




22nd INFANTRY BATTALION COLOUR PATCH

- The grey horizontal oval background indicates it belongs to the 8th Australian Division
- The upper colour of the diamond indicates battalion. The 2/22 battalion is purple.
- The lower colour indicates brigade, brigades raised in Victoria are usually red.
